POINTS TO PONDER

1. **T**hink about how Jesus must have felt when Satan came to tempt him (Jesus had been fasting for 40 days). Just like Jesus, we are often tempted with sin when we feel the weakest and most tired. How can we be ready to do what is right at those times? How was Jesus prepared to do what was right?

2. **J**esus quoted three scriptures from memory when Satan tempted him in the wilderness. Do you have any Bible verses memorized? Challenge yourself and your friends to memorize a Bible verse together. Choose a verse that will help you do the right thing when you are tempted.

3. **W**hen Jesus took a sacrificial lamb to the temple, Mary and Joseph taught him what the sacrifice represented. The lamb represented the Savior who would one day be the ultimate, perfect sacrifice for sin. Read Isaiah 40:3, John 1:29, and 1 Peter 1:18-19 to see how the Bible describes Jesus as the "Lamb of God" who takes away the sin of the world." Why was Jesus described that way?

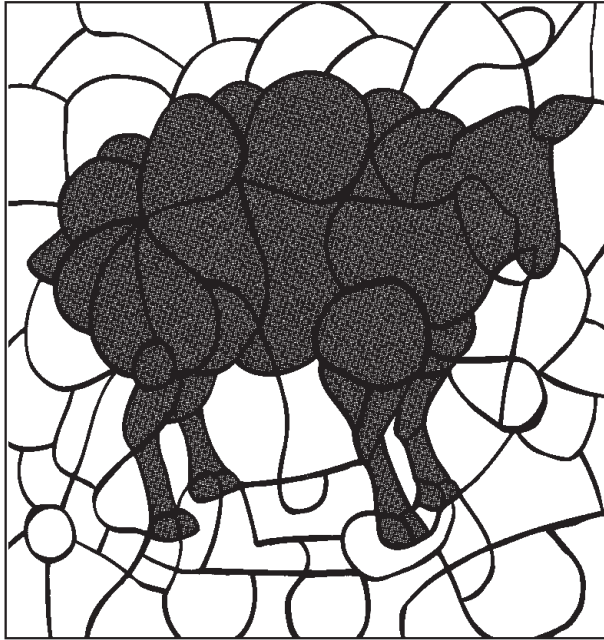
