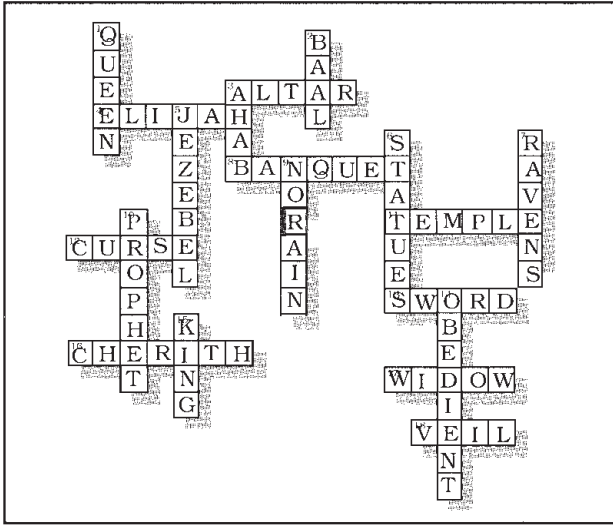


A MAP OF ELIJAH'S JOURNEYS — PAGE 29
