

Approximate Time: 5-15 minutes

- MB = The


3. Tape the word to the picture words as you decode them.

4. After all the words are decoded arrange the words to form the sentences "Follow the Prophet," "Hear and Obey"


"Listen to Your Priesthood Leaders," and









