

Approximate time: 20 minutes

A copy of the "Feed His Sheep" activity (artwork included with this lesson), scissors, What you need:

tape, pencils, two buckets, baskets or large bowls.

Preparation 1. Print out the artwork.

Activity:

2. Cut apart "I can feed His sheep by..." slips. Cut out sheep.

3. Tape sheep to buckets, baskets or large bowls.

1. Give each family member 2 slips to write down ways they can feed

His sheep.

2. Talk about the things you wrote down. (Help small children write down their ideas.)

3. Crumple slips into balls (sheep food).

4. Divide family members into two teams. Put the sheep bucket/basket/bowl on the other side of the room, one across from each team.

5. One at a time, a person from each team runs to place a crumpled ball (sheep food) in the sheep bucket to "feed the sheep", and then runs back to tag the next person on their team. The tagged person now runs to "feed the sheep". The race continues until all members on the team have "fed the sheep" twice. The first team to finish wins!

6. Discuss: How can we help each other to "feed His sheep"?
