Activity Time

Our Family "Title of Liberty"

Description:

Create a Title of Liberty for your own family displaying the things you will stand up for and protect.

What you need:

■ A copy of "Our Family Title of Liberty" artwork, markers, scissors, glue or tape and wooden dowel or stick.

Preparation:

Print artwork and cut on dotted lines. Tape or glue panels together. Tear the edge of one side if desired (Captain Moroni tore his coat).

Activity:

Explain: Captain Moroni wanted to inspire his people to stand up for their freedoms and beliefs. He tore his coat and wrote things on it that were important to him to protect. He fastened it to a stick and displayed it as he spoke to the people. He inspired them to make a covenant to keep the commandments and protect their liberty.
