Draw a face and wings on the squash.

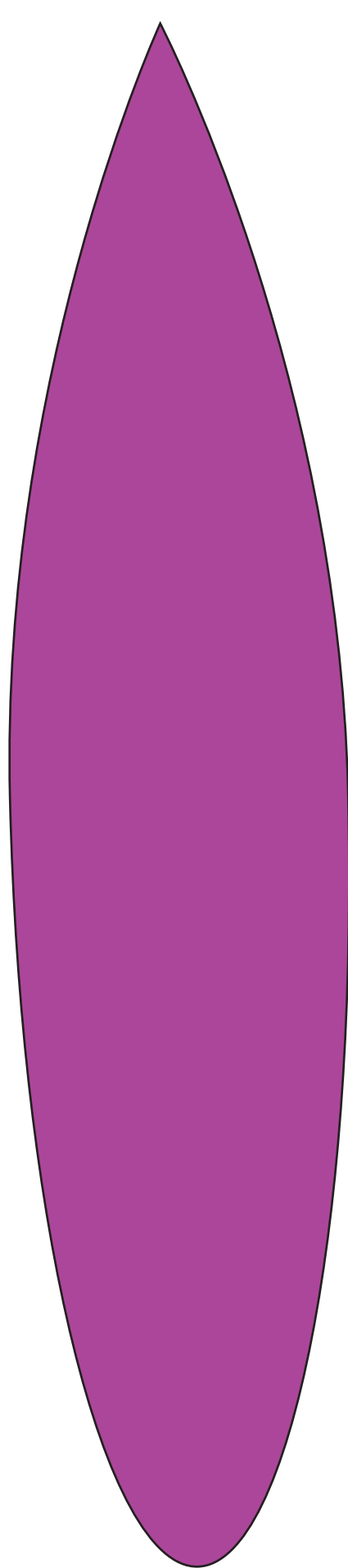
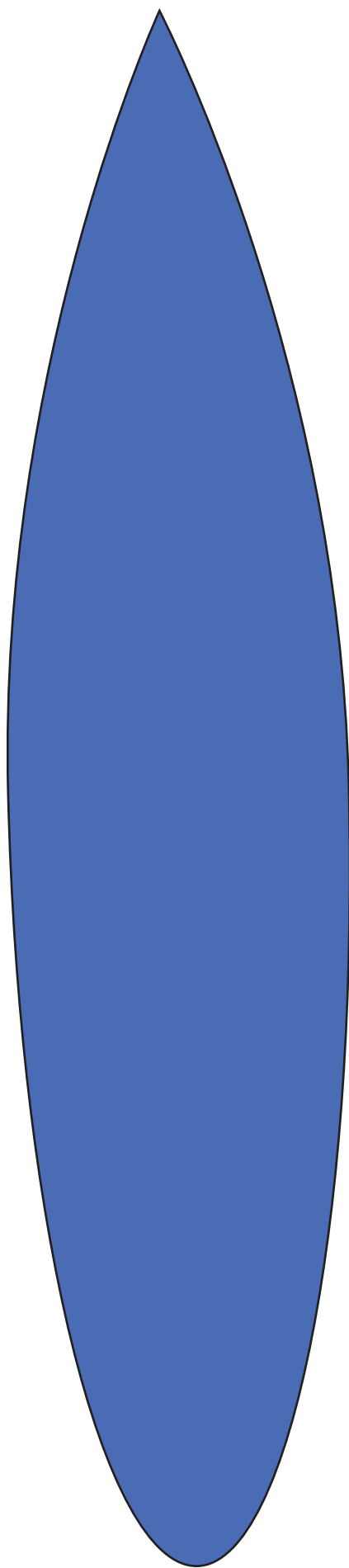
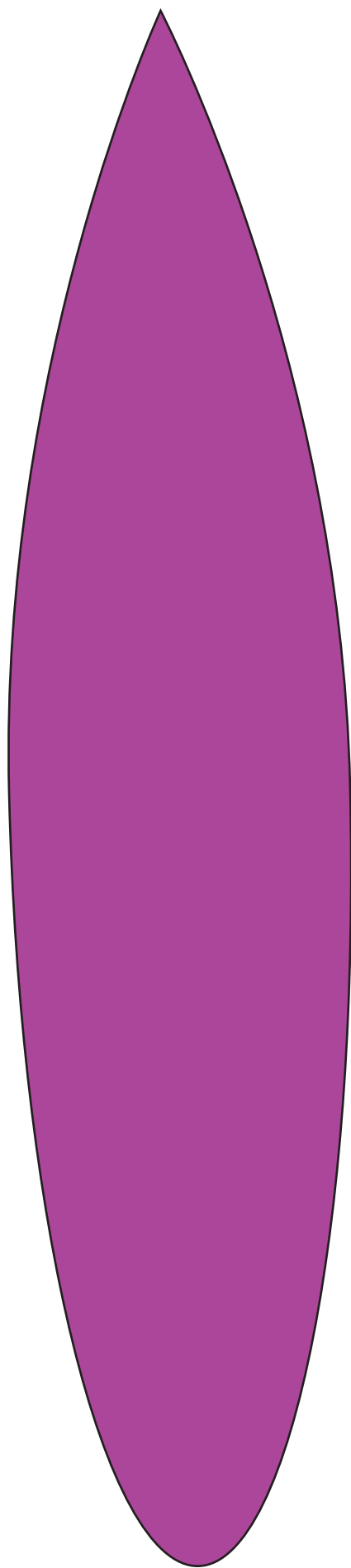
Tape headband on squash.

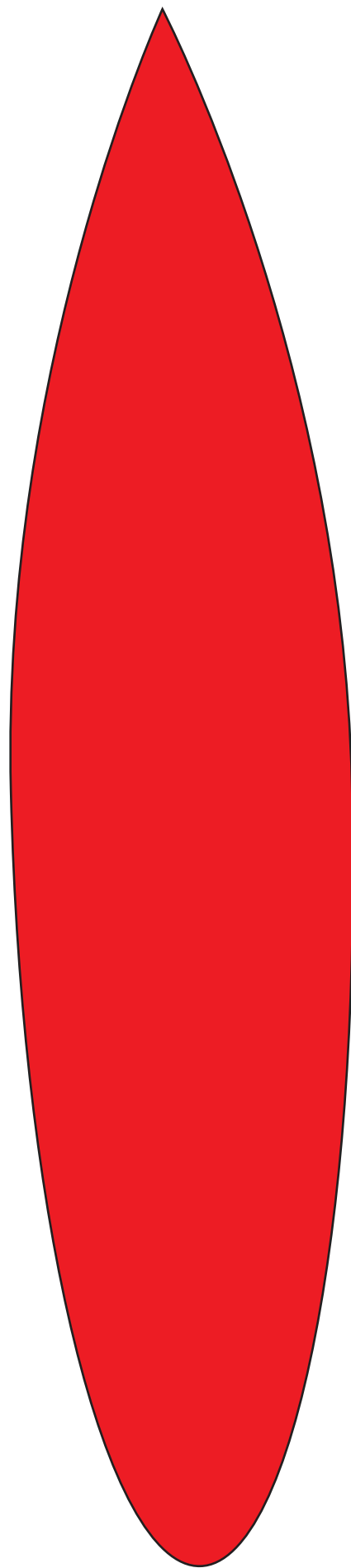
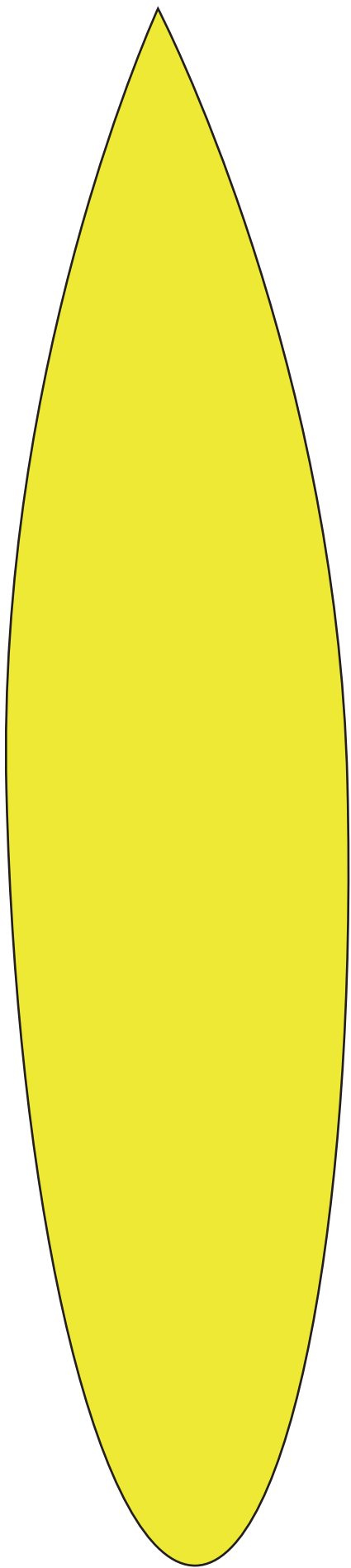
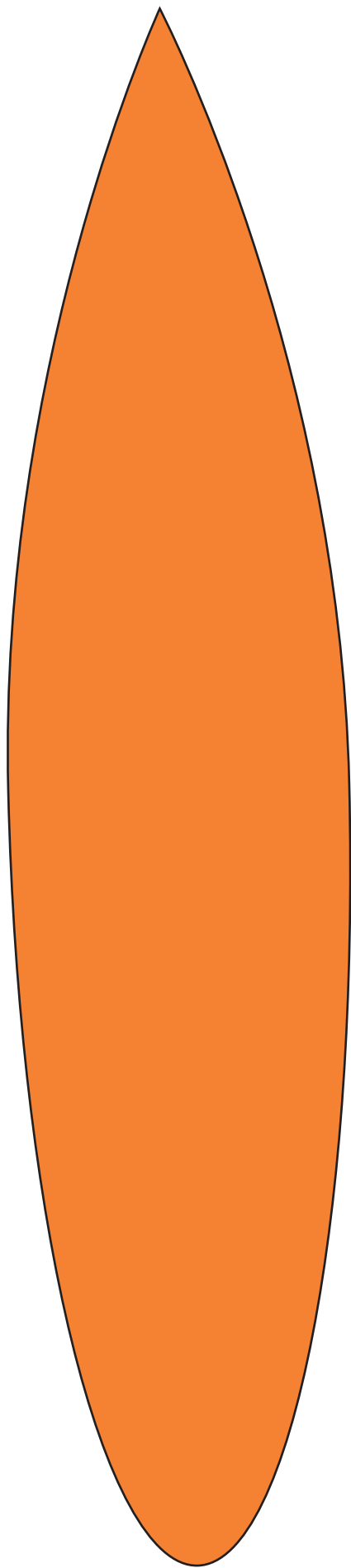
