Lesson Summary:

With so many new converts, people were confused how to practice their new faith. Joseph Smith received a revelation that gave some clear instruction to the early Saints. In this revelation, the Ten Commandments were explained and they were reminded to keep them. They were taught to remember and take care of the poor. The Lord explained a plan for the Saints to share what they had to take care of each other, especially those who had to leave so much behind to gather in Ohio. He reminds them to live together in love. The Lord asks them to have faith to hear and keep the law He has given.

Mix up the words and the pictures. Decode the picture words and then match them to the correct word.


Example:









Treat Time

H"ear" and Obey Cookies

Prep Time: 10 minutes
Chill Time: 10-20 minutes
Bake Time: 8-10 minutes



Ingredients:

1 cup butter

1 1/2 cups sugar

1 large egg

2 Tbsp. dark corn syrup or molasses

1 Tbsp. water
3 1/4 cups flour
2 tsp. baking soda
2 tsp. cinnamon
1 tsp. ground ginger
1/2 tsp. ground cloves

Instructions:

Cream the butter and sugar until light and fluffy. Add the egg, corn syrup, and water, blending well. Sift the dry ingredients together and add to the butter mixture. Chill the dough for approximately 10-20 minutes.

Treat time: Give each child two 1-inch balls of dough. Roll balls of dough in sugar and then form into ear shapes (see diagram below). Bake on ungreased cookie sheet in a preheated 350 degree F. oven for 8 to 10 minutes.
