Seek for Wisdom

Lesson Summary:

Joseph Smith knew that if he had questions he could pray and ask the Lord for wisdom and guidance and that if he followed the counsel of the Lord he and the Church would be blessed.

When Joseph and Sidney Rigdon were reading the Book of Revelation, they had questions about the symbolism John used. In Section 77, we can read about their questions and the answers the Lord gave. This shows us that if we have questions about the scriptures we can ask the Lord to help us understand.

When Joseph had questions about how to support the Church and care for the poor, he turned to the Lord in prayer. The Lord helped him to know what to do, and also taught him that the things we do in our every day lives help prepare us for eternity.

Joseph Smith prayed and received revelation for the missionaries who were called to preach the gospel. Two of those blessings and revelations are recorded in the Doctrine and Covenants in sections 79 and 80.

We can follow the example of Joseph Smith and turn to the Lord for wisdom and guidance.

Activity Time

Crowned with Wisdom

Activity: Read: D&C 66:12. Discuss the importance of not seeking riches, but instead


seeking wisdom to choose the right and trust in God in order to be crowned

Have each family member take turns wearing the crown while they tell of an

experience when they prayed for wisdom or when they used wisdom to

choose the right and trust in God.



Treat Time

Chocolate Waffle Wisdom Cookies

Prep Time: 10 minutes Bake Time: 2-3 minutes

Ingredients: 1/2 c. butter

3/4 c. sugar

2 eggs

1 tsp. vanilla 1 1/4 c. flour

1 tsp. baking powder

6 tbsp. cocoa 1/2 tsp. salt

1/2 c. powdered sugar 1/2 c. baking soda

Mesh sieve



Cream butter, sugar, eggs and vanilla together. Mix in flour, baking powder, cocoa and salt. Beat until well mixed. Heat waffle iron for about 5 minutes. Coat waffle iron with cooking spray each time you bake a new batch of cookies to prevent sticking. Drop a heaping teaspoon of dough onto each section of waffle iron. Do not spread out the dough. Close waffle iron and bake for 2-3 minutes.

Treat Time: Ask each child to use wisdom in deciding which white powder to have sprinkled on their waffle cookie. Encourage some children to gain knowledge by tasting the substances to determine which to use. Prompt others to choose the powdered sugar by having father whisper in their ear which one they should choose. While you eat your cookies discuss how wisdom can come from gaining knowledge and from trusting the promptings of the Spirit.
