"I make a decree, That in every dominion of my kingdom men tremble and fear before the God of Daniel: for he is the living God, and steadfast for ever, and his kingdom that which shall not be destroyed, and his dominion shall be even unto the end. He delivereth and rescueth, and he worketh signs and wonders in heaven and in earth, who hath delivered Daniel from the power of the lions."

Lesson Summary:


- **Immary:** Daniel is known for his great faith. When he was a boy, he and his friends (who the king called Shadrach, Meshach, and Abed-nego) were taken captive to serve in the king's court. When the king wanted the boys to eat his meat and drink his wine, which was against the law of Moses, they stayed true to the Lord and refused. When the king later decreed that everyone should worship a golden statue of him, Shadrach, Meshach, and Abed-nego refused and were thrown into a firey furnace. They were unharmed, and a fourth person was seen inside the furnace with them (who looked like the Son of God!). Later, Daniel was thrown into a lion's den because he refused to stop praying to the Lord instead of following the king's decree to only pray to the king. The Lord shut the mouths of the lions and Daniel was unharmed. In each of these events, Daniel and his friends risked death if they didn't do what the king asked, but they trusted in God and believed He could protect them.


Activity Time

| Description: | Make your own TV show and learn about how Daniel trusted in God no matter what. Then discuss how these lessons apply to your family. |

| What you need: | A copy of the "Trust in God" TV screen and film roll (artwork included with this lesson), scissors, poster board or card stock, tape and glue. |
| Preparation: | Print out the artwork. Cut out. TV screen: A. Glue onto poster board. B. Cut along dotted lines. Film roll: A. Fold along dotted lines and glue or tape together. B. Glue or tape a picture of your children where indicated. C. Glue or tape the sections together by matching up letters. |
| Activity: | Roll up movie roll. Insert the start of the movie roll into the viewer slots as shown in picture. Read the scripture and talk about how it applies to your family. Read the dialogue on the back of the movie roll as you pull it through the viewer. Discuss each situation with your family (if desired come up with situation of your own that you feel fit your family needs better). When the answer to the situation is no, discuss what you should do differently in order to answer "yes". Emphasize how always following these important principles will help us learn to always trust in God, no matter what. |



Treat Time

Lion Cookies

| Prep Time: | 15 minutes |
|------------|---------------|
| Bake Time: | 10-12 minutes |
| Cool Time: | 15 minutes |

Ingredients: 3/4 c. butter 3/4 c. packed brown sugar 1/2 c. granulated sugar 1 egg 1 tsp. vanilla 1 c. shredded carrots 1/4 c. walnuts or sunflower seeds 1 3/4 c. whole wheat flour 1 tsp. baking powder 1/4 tsp. baking soda



1/2 tsp. cinnamon1/4 tsp. ground cloves2 c. oats1/4 c. + 36 raisins1 Tbs. shredded coconut1/4 c. sliced almonds

Instructions: Cream together the butter, brown sugar, granulated sugar, egg, and vanilla until light and fluffy. Add flour, baking powder, baking soda, cinnamon, and cloves. Beat until thoroughly combined. Stir in oats, walnuts, carrots, and raisins (reserve the 36 raisins for noses).

Drop dough by rounded tablespoon fulls, 2 inches apart, onto ungreased cookie sheet. Slightly flatten and then place 2 almond slices on each for eyes, a raisin for the nose, and coconut for whiskers. Bake in a 375 degree oven for 10-12 minutes. Cool. Makes 3 dozen "Lions."

Optional: Bake cookies before adding eyes, nose, and whiskers. Remove from oven and cool. Frost with cream cheese frosting that has been colored with 4 drops red, 6 drops yellow, and 2 drops blue food coloring. Then add the eyes, nose and whiskers.

Treat Time: Have children help make the cookies. While you're adding the ingredients discuss why Heavenly Father wants us, like Daniel and his friends, to eat more vegetables and fruit like the raisins and the carrots and nuts and seeds like the walnuts, almonds and sunflower seeds, and whole grains like the whole wheat flour and oats.
