Written in Our Hearts


Description: Talk about the importance of covenants and having His law written in our hearts. Have each family member write or draw something in these paper heart frames that shows how they feel about the Savior.

What you need: ■ A copy of the “Written in Our Hearts” artwork for each child, scissors, pencils or crayons


Preparation: Print out artwork and cut out hearts.


Have each family member write or draw something that shows how they feel about the savior inside of the paper hearts. Display the paper hearts this week where you will see them often.




